

Political Science Minor

Program Description:

The minor is a general political science minor that allows students to take coursework across the different subfields in political science. This provides options to students beyond the major to broaden student learning and understanding in an important discipline that will impact their lives beyond college.

Students in more than one minor offered through the political science department cannot overlap more than one course between two minors.

Degree Requirements:

The proposed minor consists of 18 credit hours of coursework, at least 12 hours of POLS courses at the Junior/Senior level from the list of political science courses offered in the department. Nine hours of Junior/Senior level courses must be taken in residence at KU. Students in more than one minor offered through the political science department cannot overlap more than one course between the two minors.

Admission Requirements

To declare a Political Science minor, you must fill out a minor declaration form in consultation with the Undergraduate Director.
